

Pictured below are before and after pictures of the exterior painting that was completed in the fall of 2016. The exterior walls are now a brilliant white.

Also, there are pictures of the new roof project. Funds have been provided for this project and it should be completed in March of 2017. A very durable "Galvalume" metal is being used that reflects the color of the sky. Soffits, eaves, and fascia will also be installed to give it a finished look and protect better from storms and small animals.

A covered porch will be added to the front with a ramp and steps, and a sidewalk will run the length of the building on both sides.

The five windows on the front will be replaced at a later date. The two lower windows will be in memory of M/M A.B. McReynolds and M/M Lawrence Layman. The upper three will honor The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit.

The exterior will receive a new roof, paint, windows, sidewalks, steeple (which has been donated), and a covered porch.

The interior will contain a chapel, restrooms, storage, and foyer on the ground level, and divided sleeping quarters, restrooms, and a meeting area on the upper level.

There are 27 lower windows on the sides of the Chapel. There are also 30 windows that access the upstairs of the Chapel. The windows will be vinyl with double pane insulated glass to accommodate future heating and cooling of the building. The lower windows will be covered with a permanent film that will simulate stained glass and depict the entire life of Christ. These will have tremendous influence and impact our children for generations to come.

Cost of each of the lower windows is \$750 per window. Cost of the upper windows is \$250 per window.

The Lord has led us and we see the need to share in this historic and spiritual project.
