

Tomoka Christian is a non-denominational, missions-oriented church spreading God's love by reaching out to people in the community, the nation and throughout the world. Services are designed to lead people to a personal encounter with God. The goal is to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ. In the Worship Center, contemporary music accompanied by multimedia enhances the messages presented each week by the pastor, who guides the congregation in applying God's Word to everyday life. The main services on weekends feature communion.


Established in 1970, the church has been led for 25 years by Joe Putting, lead pastor, who is overseen by a team of elders. Under the leadership of Pastor Joe, the church has adopted a mission-focused mentality: Bringing the hope and love of Jesus to those locally and abroad who are struggling, marginalized

or seeking connection. The church's guide are scriptures such as Acts 15:19: "It is my judgment, therefore, that we should not make it difficult for the Gentiles who are turning to God." Our vision, as a part of the body of Christ, is to change the generation in which we live. We need to do everything in our power to help people find Jesus so that they are prepared for eternity."

An unusual feature of Tomoka Christian is that those who choose to join the church are called partners, not members. This wording shift underscores the importance of participation and giving, implied by partnership, rather than receiving, implied by membership. Partners regularly are offered a wide variety of interesting and fulfilling opportunities to make a difference for Christ to those in need.

Through the grace of God and a commitment to give, Tomoka has helped launch hundreds of churches and has built or funded orphanages, medical clinics and food pantries all over the world. Gifts to missions also rebuild homes and lives following disasters, assist with adoption fees, provide free medical care to those without insurance, support evangelists, feed and clothe the homeless, share the love of Jesus with inmates, and train pastors in politically sensitive countries. This support typically yields annual gift totals of one million dollars. The church leadership desires to set an example of tithing, so the first 10 percent of undesignated gifts goes to missions. Meanwhile, each year the church sends dozens of short-term mission teams consisting of church partners.

was preaching a revival in Texas last Fall when the local minister requested to meet for lunch and discuss ideas as to how he could help their small, struggling congregation have a more powerful effect in their community. He simply asked, "If you were the preacher here, what would you do to get this church moving forward?" I wrote down ten things from my 45 years of ministry and building congregations and shared them with him. At the conclusion he asked, "I don't know what you planned to preach tonight for the



revival meeting but could you cancel that and preach this?" So I did. The response was very positive but in the discussion that followed one fact became very clear. This small, struggling church would not be able to accomplish these things without some outside help.

Upon returning home I began to share these ideas with the "Mission Possible" leadership team consisting of myself, Jaydee Miller, Sam Ray, Dr. Mark Berrier, and Dean Sharp. As a result of this discussion "12 Proactive Strategies to Activate the Power of God in the Smaller Church" was born. We gleaned material from Jackie Miller of Versailles Kentucky, Jaydee's father, who taught both Jaydee and me personal evangelism and church building and is still building churches at the age of 84. Then we contacted Mike Baker of Olney, Illinois, who is one of the most dynamic Evangelists in our Brotherhood today for a contribution to the discussion. After that we involved the veteran missionary Reggie Thomas who contributed much discussion and materials to the effort. Both Cecil Todd and Murray Hollis contributed much advice; then we gleaned material from a book by A. B. McReynolds entitled Plans For A Three Months Christ Centered Crusade. We spent many hours in study of the New Testament teachings on The Great Commission and related verses as well as the history of the First Century Church as to how they evangelized the

world so effectively. The result is a new program which will be offered as an outreach ministry of The Kiamichi Mountains Christian Mission to struggling congregations. This program will be presented in its entirety on Thursday morning of the Men's Clinic. The Mission will be limited as to how many congregations they can serve so the program is <u>duplicatable</u> for others to use the material.

As a part of "Operation Jumpstart", Dr. Berrier and I have spent several months developing a presentation of The Great Commission which mirrors the approach of the First Century Church. It is called "Five Simple Steps for Sharing the Good News". This

approach is not only Biblical and effective, but so simple a ten-year old child can use it to fulfill The Great Commission. Why have we made personal evangelism so difficult that many adults cannot share the Gospel, when it was common in the early Church for women and children to do so? It is because we have a tendency to skip the first step of sharing the Good News and jump right to the process of salvation.



This is all a "God Thing" but the following is a <u>MAJOR GOD THING!</u> I invited Larry West to be a featured speaker for the Men's Clinic this year on the recommen-

dation of others I fully trust. I did not completely research all the ministry in which Larry is involved until after we developed "12 Proactive Strategies". I knew he was a dynamic preacher and evangelist and on staff at the Church where the "Duck Dynasty" group was involved in West Monroe, Louisiana, and that he was father-in-law to one of the Robertson boys. But here is what I did not know: He has led a ministry among our non-instrumental brethren called "We Care Ministries" for 45 years which serves struggling congregations in the same way. He is 45 years ahead of us and has agreed to help us develop our program in many ways so we do not have to "reinvent the wheel". We will be allowed to duplicate some of his material, and he has invited our leadership to West Monroe for a training session. **WOW!** I would like to think I am such a genius and skilled developer to organize things this good on my own but it would not be true. What I have is a friend who can. He is God, and my Father who makes me the best I can be.



We Care Ministries offers a campaign that runs 12 days and involves gospel preaching, door knocking, classroom training in the We Care Approach and the presenting of Gospel of Jesus to lost people. Thirty-five to 100 outside campaigners come in to train the local members to reach their friends and neighbors. And they do it by going out with them into the field.

We now offer <u>We Care Small Church Campaigns</u>. These are designed for churches with 25 to 75 members. The SCC involves fewer outside workers and one or two of the full-time staff workers to come and train members over a shorter span of time. These campaigns begin Friday evening with lessons designed to motivate the members to participate in the door knocking effort or to take our outside trained workers to their friends and family members.
