Chief Justice Roy Moore

In 2003, Chief Justice Moore was removed from his position by a judicial panel for refusing to remove a Ten Commandments monument that he installed in the rotunda of the Alabama Judicial Building to acknowledge the sovereignty of God. From 2003 until 2012, Chief Justice Moore served as President of the Foundation for Moral Law in Montgomery, speaking throughout the Country and filing amicus curiae briefs regarding the United States Constitution in Federal District Courts, State Supreme Courts, U.S. Courts of Appeal and the United States Supreme

Court. Chief Justice Moore was overwhelmingly re-elected by a vote of the people of Alabama as Chief Justice in November of 2012 and took office in January of 2013.


Featured Speaker Tuesday Night!

Mat Staver — Founder of “Liberty Counsel”

After completing his studies in religion and becoming a pastor, Dean Staver entered law school and the legal profession. Following law school, he worked in private practice with the law firm of Zimmerman, Shuffield, Kiser and Sutcliffe in Orlando, Florida. In 1989, Dean Staver became the Founder and President of Staver & Associates, a statewide law firm with offices in Orlando and Tallahassee, Florida. He also was the Founder and President of The Staver Group, a statewide governmental consulting organization. That same year, Dean Staver became the Founder, President and General Counsel of Liberty Counsel and currently serves as Chairman of the Board. Liberty Counsel is a litigation, education and policy organization with offices in Orlando, Florida, Lynchburg, Virginia, and hundreds of affiliate attorneys in all 50 states. Liberty Counsel was one of the first religious liberty litigation organizations in the country. In the early 1990s, Dean Staver was one of the first to pioneer a new legal strategy and theory in litigating religious liberty cases, using the First Amendment Free Speech Clause.

Reggie Thomas — Founder of “White Fields Overseas Evangelism”

During the past 37 years, Reggie has preached and directed great crusades in six continents of the world. In Africa he has preached to some of the most primitive people on earth and thousands were baptized. In India he has preached in the world’s largest leper village. He has criss-crossed Australia and New Zealand, and has preached on many islands of the seas. He was preaching in Chile, South America at the time of the attempted coup, June 30, 1973. He has lived through 2 coups in Nigeria, 2 coups in Ghana, and 5 coups in Haiti. He has traveled over three million (3,000,000) miles preaching the Gospel of Jesus literally AROUND THE WORLD. He has a thrilling story to tell of what God has done in overseas evangelism. Since 1966 Mr. Thomas has traveled in 80 different countries of the world. To date, over 275,000 souls have been baptized into Christ as a part of this overseas ministry.

Wednesday night of the Clinic will be promoted throughout the Mountains as a “One Night Revival” and we will invite everyone in this area to participate. **LINK UNION**, a family Bluegrass and Gospel group who is featured at Silver Dollar City will provide special music for the service. Following the Revival service they will perform a full concert of Gospel and Bluegrass music for all to enjoy. This will be a great night of Praise, Preaching, and Evangelistic Outreach.



Directly from the Director



The Kiamichi Christian Men's Clinic is only weeks away. This event has been a life-changing experience for thousands of men over the past 64 years. Year 65 will follow in that same great tradition. In 1962 my father was a new Christian. He attended worship and put his two dollars in the plate but not much else. It all changed when the preacher invited

him to attend the Kiamichi Christian Men's Clinic in Honobia, Oklahoma. He returned from that experience completely "sold-out" for Christ! Now his family must attend Sunday School, Worship, A.M. and P.M., Wednesday night Prayer Meeting, Saturday work days, and every night of a three-week Revival, even Saturday! A tithe plus offerings found their way to the offering plate and even special financial commitments to the missionaries. One week he had the choice of paying the electric bill or sending his commitment to the missionary. You guessed it; we sat in the dark for three days until he got another paycheck. He said his family could live without electricity for a few days so the missionary could go tell people about Jesus; people who lived without electricity every day! He started bringing me with him to the Clinic a few years later. **Women!** Do you want to see your husbands become the spiritual leaders of your family? **Send them to the Clinic!** **Fathers!** Do you want to see your sons inspired to Christian Service as preachers and missionaries? **Bring them to the Clinic!** **Preachers!** Do you want to see your elders and deacons become the spiritual force in your congregation that they should be? **Come with them to the Clinic!** **The Kiamichi Christian Men's Clinic; Changing Men's Lives Since 1949!**

Come early for the Gospel Sing on Monday night at 7:00. We have a great line-up of singers again this year. The Thursday night Fish Fry is all set to happen. DUCK COMMANDER NIGHT


at 2014 Men's Clinic




